

## Arrangements for services in the church

### Restrictions which will apply until 27 June

Members, friends and visitors, including children, will be welcome.

Please plan to arrive in good time. You are currently required by law to **wear a face covering** for the whole time you are in the church. This applies to everyone except children aged under 11 or those who are exempt.

You are asked to pre-register by emailing [churchsecretaries@trinitywimbledon.org](mailto:churchsecretaries@trinitywimbledon.org) giving your **name and those of your household who will be attending**. This is so that NHS Test and Trace can trace your contacts in the event that you, or anyone else attending the service, contract Covid-19 in the next few days. These details will be held by the church and destroyed after 21 days unless NHS Test and Trace requests them, in which case we will comply. We are also displaying an NHS Test and Trace QR code, and you may if you wish scan that with your smartphone.

**If you are feeling unwell or have any Covid-19 symptoms please do not come to church.**

**While on the premises please maintain a social distance of 2 metres from anyone not in your household.**

The Door Stewards will direct you to a seat which is spaced appropriately.

If you have children with you, they should go straight to the Mansel Road Centre at 11:00 for their activities.

**There will be no congregational singing of hymns at this time.**

No **offering** will be taken, but we encourage you to make your normal contribution for the work of the church by bank transfer or by using the 'Virgin moneygiving Donate' button on the church website. Collection plates will also be available at the back of the church for any cash donations.

**After the service, please do not congregate inside the church.** If you wish to speak to others, do so outside well away from the church doors and continue to observe social distancing.
